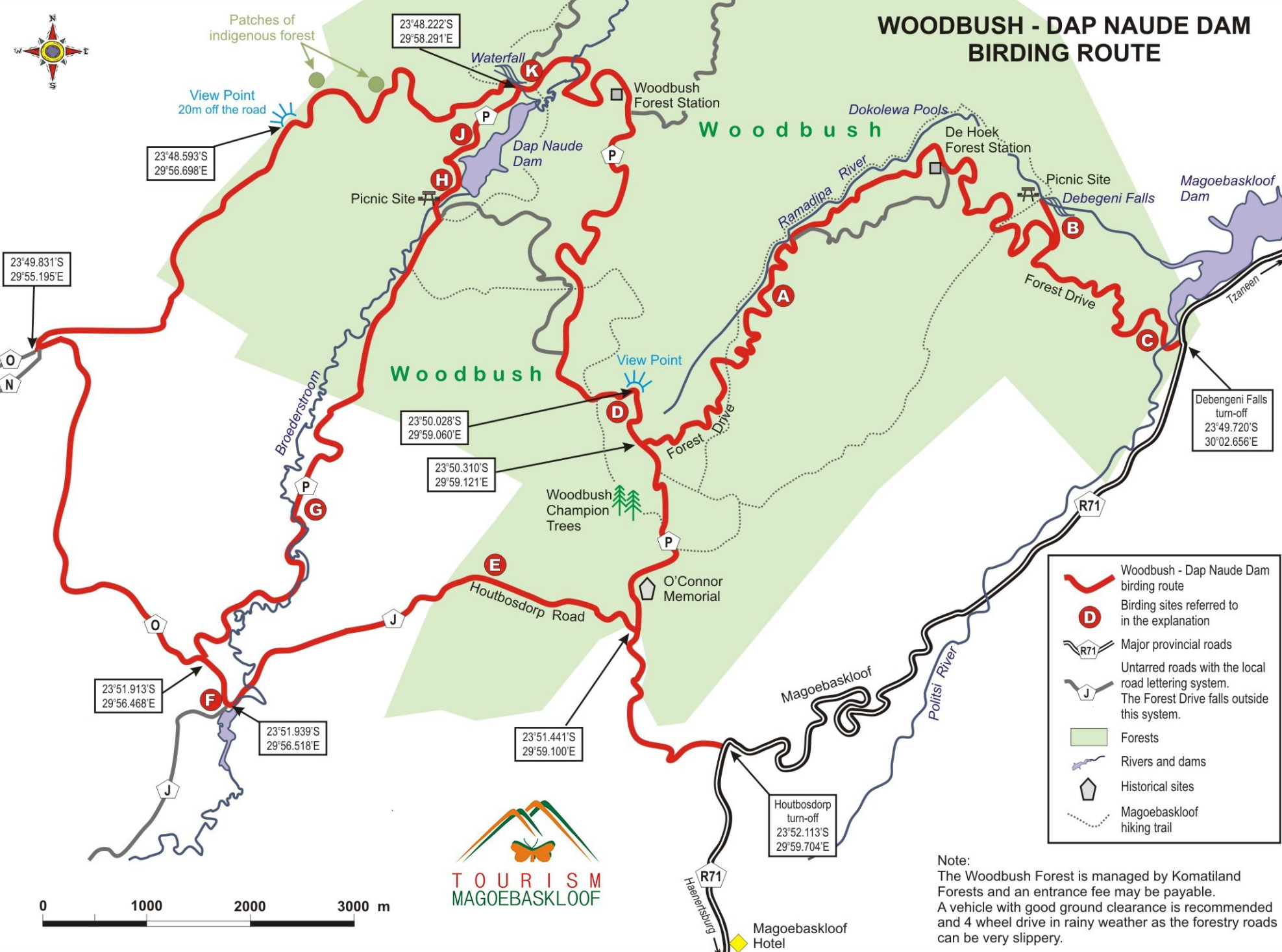


WOODBUSH - DAP NAUDE DAM BIRDING ROUTE
